Regulations and Conditions for Internship Training under the Supervision of the College of Medicine for Medical School Graduates from Outside the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

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- 1. The student must be a Saudi national or the son/ daughter of a Saudi female citizen.
- The student has completed graduation requirements and obtained proof of graduation
- 3. The internship year begins on the first of July of the Gregorian year.
- 4. The application process opens at the beginning of March for a duration of two weeks, and it is done through email to the Internship Unit. This is followed by a selection process among the applicants based on criteria set by the Internship Committee, with a specific number of doctors chosen to take the written exam.
- 5. It is mandatory to pass the written exam held at the College of Medicine, Imam Mohammad bin Saud Islamic University, with a minimum score of 60% of the total marks.
- 6. The results are announced three months prior to the start of the internship year, with no more than three interns selected in a single training year.
- 7. The entire training period must be completed in hospitals and healthcare centers recognized by the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties and approved hospitals by the Internship Unit.
- 8. The trainee must adhere to the training regulations according to the regulatory rules of the internship year.
- 9. Stipend will be provided to the intern according to the regulations and rules applicable in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
- 10. The university has no financial obligations towards the hospitals.
- 11. The Internship Unit has the authority to remove supervision from interns in the case of unexcused absence or violation of the university regulations and rules.

12. Requirements:

- A letter from the Ministry of Education or the Saudi Cultural Attaché in the country of study, approving the application for the internship year in hospitals within the Kingdom.
- A letter from the university where the student studied, stating that there is no objection to training in the internship year at the College of Medicine at Imam Mohammed bin Saud Islamic University.
- A copy of a document proving the completion of academic years from the Ministry of Education's equivalence, or a letter from the cultural attaché in the country of study.
- A copy of the academic transcript.
- National ID for Saudis for a Saudi female citizen's son/ daughter. Iqama ID and a copy of the birth certificate if the applicant is a son/ daughter of a Saudi female citizen.
- 13. The Internship Committee has the right to modify and update the regulations and conditions in accordance with the unit.
