#### **University Care for Students with Disabilities**

In line with the objectives of Saudi Vision 2030, which emphasizes supporting people with disabilities in all fields, the university has paid special attention to male and female students with disabilities. Paragraph (16) of Article 1 of the Student Rights and Duties states:

"Providing students with disabilities with facilities that enable them to achieve academic success"

The university has mobilized all material and non-material resources to serve students with disabilities by providing human and material resources to support them in various academic, psychological, social, and technical fields. This is represented by the Center for Students with Disabilities under the supervision of the Deanship of Student Affairs. The Center offers services to support students with disabilities in achieving an independent and empowered personality in all psychological, social, and academic aspects, providing many support services that positively impact the university life and professional future of male and female students.

## **Objectives**

- 1-Introducing the services of the Center for Students with Disabilities.

- 3- Preparing and implementing guidance and counseling programs for students with disabilities.
- 4- Collecting data and information about students with disabilities.
- 5- Activating the inclusion of people with disabilities in cultural and sports activities.
- 6- Participating in periodic events for people with disabilities.

#### Services of the Center:

The university strives to provide the best programs and facilities for students with disabilities. Some of the services offered by the Center include:

- Providing support, counseling, and academic guidance in coordination with academic advising unit.
- Providing psychological support and assisting them in coping with disability-related challenges in coordination with the Care Unit.
- Communication with colleges to solve student problems related to disabilities.
- Raising awareness about various disabilities and how to handle them.
- Integrating students with disabilities into various activities.
- Participating in global events related to disabilities.
- Communicating with families to explain how to deal with students with disabilities at the university level.
- Issuing letters to authorize reader allowance disbursement for blind students and assistive tools, and following up on their disbursement.
- Adapting the university's architectural environment to be compatible with students with disabilities according to international standards.
- Providing assistive devices for students with disabilities.
- Following up and solving problems related to disability allowances for students.
- Coordinating with ministries, agencies, and associations concerned with the affairs of people with disabilities.
- Issuing statement for each student clarifying their type of disability and how to deal with it.
- Providing post-graduation transitional services, such as coordinating to help some students secure jobs.
- Organizing trips and visits for students with disabilities.
- Issuing special parking permits for students with disabilities within the university campus.
- Holding introductory meetings with new students to explain the center's services and how to access them.
- Organizing specialized courses for people with disabilities.

#### Units in the Center:

#### Social Guidance Unit:

Provides awareness and counseling services for students with disabilities, addressing social obstacles and problems that may limit their social adaptation, and working to achieve comprehensive personal growth for students.

#### **Academic Affairs and Examinations Unit:**

Handles academic matters related to schedules, addition/dropping of courses, communication with faculty, and providing support during exams, in addition to collecting data and information about each student.

#### Learning Disabilities Unit:

Provides academic, psychological, and social services for students with disorders in one or more basic psychological processes related to understanding or using spoken or written language, including listening, thinking, speaking, reading, writing, or math, which are unrelated to sensory or intellectual disabilities.

#### **Hearing Impairment Unit:**

Provides services for students with hearing impairments in coordination with colleges and faculty members.

#### Technical Affairs Unit (Visual Impairment):

Provides technical support for students with visual impairments (blind or visually impaired) by keeping up with modern technological trends to meet their needs and train them to achieve a high degree of independence. الزهران

#### **Activities and Support Programs Unit:**

Develops annual plans for activities and programs for students with disabilities and supervises their implementation after approval by the university council, in coordination with the Programs and Activities Vice-deanship at the Deanship of Student Affairs.

# Rights and Duties of Students with Disabilities in the University:

## Rights:

- Access to appropriate facilities according to the nature of the disability.
- Equal educational opportunities in line with the type of disability.
- Complete confidentiality of all information.
- Freedom to request or decline the Center's services based on personal preference.
- The university commits not to mention the student's disability in the graduation document.

#### **Duties:**

- Submitting documents from approved sources explaining the nature of the disability and recommended accommodations.
- Introducing themselves to the center and requesting appropriate accommodations.
- Adhering to procedures related to academic support measures and assistive devices in a timely manner.
- Communicating with the Center to discuss exam and course-related arrangements.
- Performing academic procedures directly through self-service platforms.
- Coordinating exam schedules in advance to determine appropriate accommodations.
- Communicating with specialists at the Center to discuss exam and course-related arrangements.
- Adhering to general ethics and morals in dealing with students, staff, and faculty members.



# Academic Services

#### **Academic Services**

The Center for Students with Disability at the Deanship of Student Affairs, in cooperation with all university colleges and their supporting deanships, provides academic facilities for male and female university students with disabilities. The main services are:

- Organizing introductory meetings for new students with disabilities to explain the Center's services.
- Recommending academic accommodations after reviewing certified documents and reports that describes the nature of the disability or the health condition.
- Assigning an academic advisor in each college to provide support and guidance in coordination with academic counseling unit.
- Assisting with course registration, add/drop processes.
- Communicating with colleges and faculty to clarify required accommodations and solving disability-related problems.
- Providing exam support services.
- Offering academic consultations for students with disabilities.
- Providing a database for each student with relevant information.
- Issuing statements for students with disabilities outlining required needs and accommodations.



# National Events

The Center for Students with Disabilities at the Deanship of Student Affairs participates in the university's activities on the occasion of National Day and Founding Day celebrations by highlighting the wise leadership's care for people with disabilities and showcasing Saudi Arabia's efforts in providing educational services to students with disabilities. # Agreements and Partnerships

# Memorandum of Understanding between the University and the Authority for the Care of Persons with Disabilities.




The university signed a memorandum of understanding with the Authority for the Care of Persons with Disabilities, in the presence of His Excellency the President of the University, Prof. Ahmed S. Al-Aamri, and the CEO of the Authority, His Excellency Dr. Hisham M. Al-Haidari, on 3 October, 2021 at the university's headquarters. The agreement aims to increase the empowerment of students with disabilities to benefit from educational and employment programs at the university, cooperate in designing training programs for students with disabilities, cooperate in the field of research and consulting studies, strive to raise awareness in the university community about the rights of students with disabilities, and cooperate in identifying the labor market's need for employees with disabilities.

# A Memorandum of Understanding with Adults Motor Disability Association "Harakia"

The university signed a memorandum of understanding with Adults Motor Disability Association "Harakia". The agreement aims to activate cooperation between the university and the association in the fields of studies, research, training, and media development.





# Collaboration Agreement with the Association for People with Disabilities and Special Needs "Sharaka"



On 24 May 2023, the University, represented by the Center for Students with Disabilities at the Deanship of Student Affairs, signed a memorandum of cooperation with the Association for People with Disabilities and Special Needs "Sharaka." The agreement aims to build effective partnerships with community institutions inside and outside the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to serve people with disabilities and special needs, achieve their full integration, and undertaking all actions that serve this purpose; particularly through collaboration with prestigious institutions across various complementary fields that serve them, through their own efforts and through partners. Under this agreement, the university provides training, professional, and rehabilitation programs for students with disabilities.



# Collaboration Agreement with the Sa3ee Waqf Foundation for the Rehabilitation and Employment of People with Disabilities



The university, represented by the Center for Students with Disabilities at the Deanship of Student Affairs, signed a joint collaboration agreement with the Sa3ee Waqf Foundation for the Rehabilitation and Employment of Persons with Disabilities. The agreement aims to build joint cooperation in the rehabilitation, training, and employment of students with disabilities, and to cooperate in providing community initiatives for students with disabilities.

This is in line with the Saudi Vision 2030, which aims to facilitate access to job opportunities to people with disabilities that give them independence and help them become active members of society. Some examples of this are:

The Center organized a visit to a restaurant opened by student Abdo Al-Asmari (visually impaired). The visit was attended by the Dean of Student Affairs, vice deans, and directors of the deanship's departments.
