Course Description

English Language (IELTS Preparation) is a review course that covers the four skill areas: Listening, Speaking, Reading &Writing. Its goal is to enable students to develop all their English skills to a level of 5.5 on the IELTS exam. The focus is to prepare students to successfully complete the IELTS exam required for acceptance into the College of Medicine.

Course Objectives .

The course content will focus on meeting the course objectives described below:

- 1. Strengthen student's study skills in preparation for the IELTS exam.
- 2. Help each student improve their areas of deficiency.
- 3. Accustom students to the format and requirements of the IELTS exam.

Course Policy

The following course policies and expectations apply to all parts of ENG 078

• Attendance
