

A summary of “Rulings on Detached Parts and Relevant Contemporary Issues”

This is a summary of the book “Rulings on Detached Parts and Relevant Contemporary Issues” which is originally a doctoral thesis submitted to the Department of Jurisprudence entitled “ Rulings on Detached Parts in Islamic Jurisprudence”. One reason for the choice of that topic was the need to collect and edit the issues of the topic as there has not been any book or study on this topic, based on an extensive review of the relevant literature. Another reason was that the study focused on some contemporary issues and matters that needed to be documented jurisprudentially, presented correctly, studied and researched duly. A third reason was that the ruling on many jurisprudential issues differed, and that had an effect on detached and relevant parts, which all required a detailed study.

The study aimed to extract, collect and study the rulings

on detached parts from all sources of jurisprudence “Fiqh” in detail. It also aimed to draw up general rules governing the kinds of detached parts and the rulings on them. Accordingly, referring to many issues and sub-issues which might arise and need to be researched would be much easier. Finally, the study aimed to illustrate the effect of detached parts on jurisprudential rulings and the differences resulting from that.

The researcher divided the study into an introduction, four chapters with sections and subsections and a conclusion with the most important findings.
